Finding a Book

Before your library workshop:

- 1. Go to the library website, <u>library.duke.edu</u>.
- 2. In the main search box, switch to a **'Books & Media'** search. Search for a book related to your research topic.



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3. Find an available *print/physical* book and go get it from the library it is located in. TIPS: Make sure the book status = Available; Click the 'Stacks' hyperlink to pop up a map to the library & floor where it is located; Note: The green 'Request' button will only work when a book is unavailable or off-site. Most of the time, you will have to go get the book.



- 4. Check out the book at the library service desk using your Duke Card.
- 5. Write a few sentences describing any obstacles or observations you made about the experience of navigating the library and finding this book.
- 6. Bring the book to class.
